Have a good weekend.

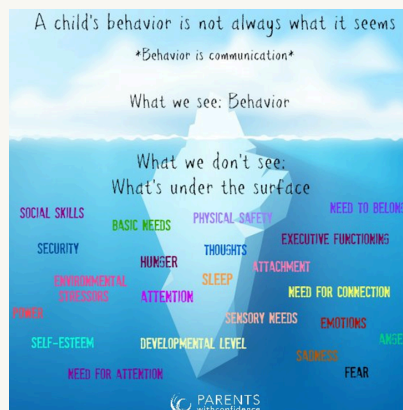
