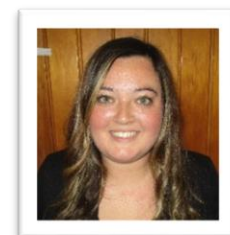

MASKS is our school charity and all funds raised will be used to benefit the children of the Vale Federation.

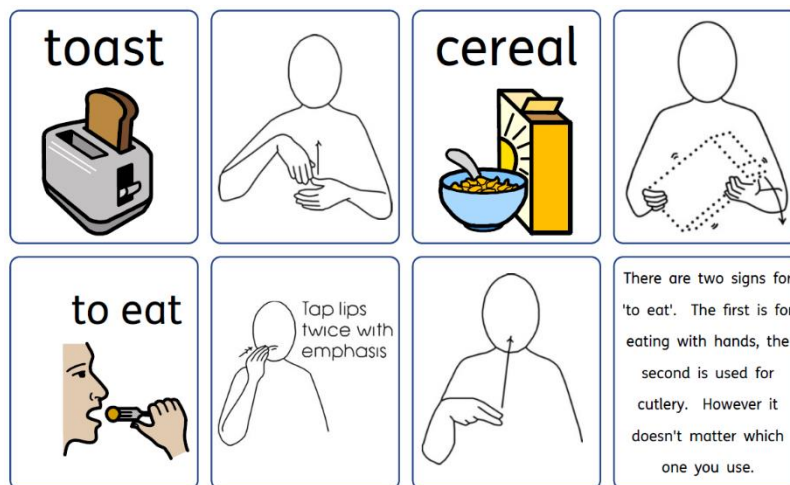
If you work for a company that you think might participate in this event, please do encourage them to do so.

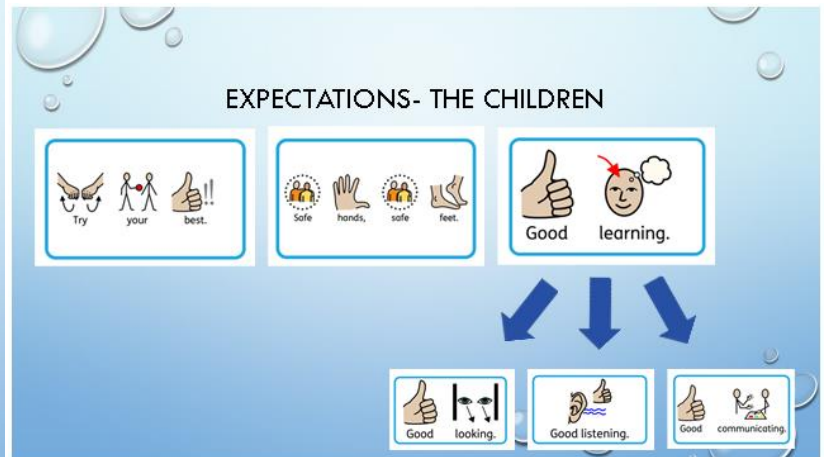

Local Information: HS2 Railway Works:

Summary of the works taking place on the A41/Blackgrove Road are as follows:

- Due to the utility works in preparation for the A41 realignment, traffic management will be in place on **Blackgrove Road from Monday 16 October to Friday 21 October 9:30am to 3:30pm** and;
- Traffic management will be in place on the **A41 from Monday 16 October to Friday 21 October 8:00pm to 6:00am**

Summary of the works taking place on the A418 Oxford Road are as follows:

- Due to utility and de-vegetation works in preparation for the A418 realignment, traffic management will be in place on the **A418 Oxford Road from Monday 9 October to Tuesday 10 October from 9:00am to 3:00pm**

Summary of the works taking place on the Waddesdon Greenway are as follows:

- Monday 23 to Friday 27 October – Footpath closure. These dates are updated from our previous notification.
- This is so a temporary footpath/cycle path/bridleway crossing can be built which will ensure the public can continue to pass safely across the route of the railway, unimpeded by our works site.
- The diversion will be open for use from Saturday 28 October.
