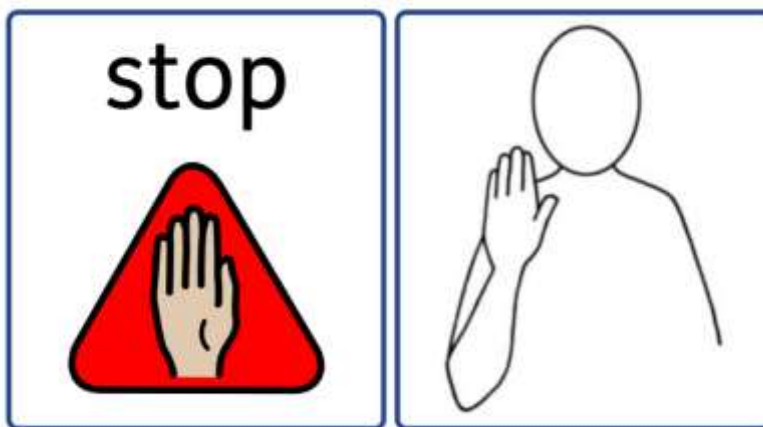


SCHOOL MEAL ORDERING FOR NEXT HALF TERM:
