### Class update: Life Skills and Enrichment

In Sixth Form, Stocklake Park students continue their journey into the world of work through their WRL lessons (Work Related Learning.) There is an emphasis on Health and Safety, using equipment correctly, enterprise, and teamwork through practical tasks including horticulture and site maintenance activities and projects. Students learn about aspects of different workplaces, roles, and responsibilities, and begin to identify personal skills and qualities.

Sixth Form students are actively encouraged and expected to seek work placement opportunities in an area of their choice; we have had a successful placement at a local car garage, local supermarkets, and charity shops as well as students delivering an activity to younger students in school.

Pathways, a new WRL course for Sixth Form, gives students the chance to both use and develop transferable work skills, develop working relationships, promote a positive attitude to work, and employability potential. We are currently offering General services and Maintenance, Business and Enterprise, and Performing Arts.

Being able to give our students a variety of work experiences, they are able to make informed choices about their next steps in life.
