We had a lovely visit from a farm last week where the students enjoyed interacting with the lambs and goats.

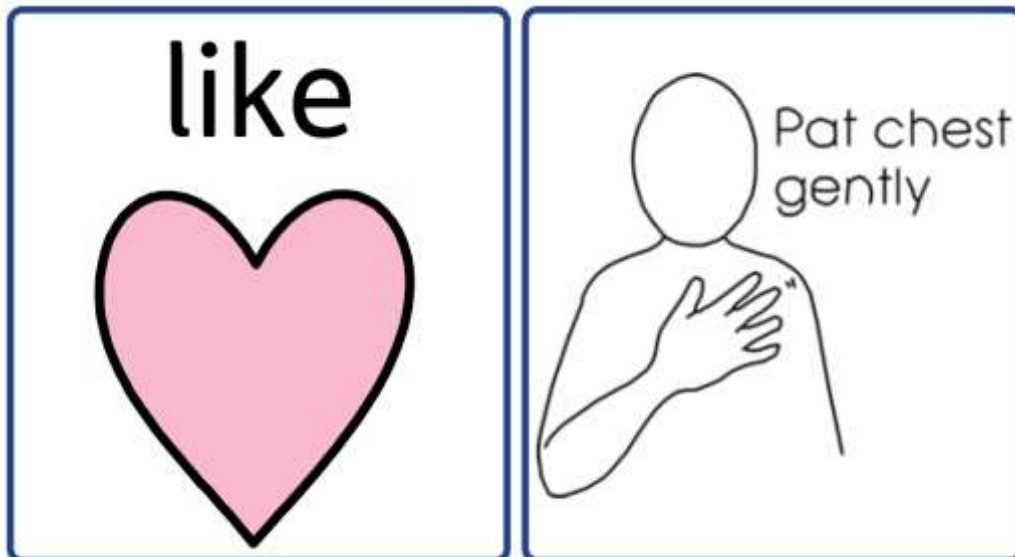

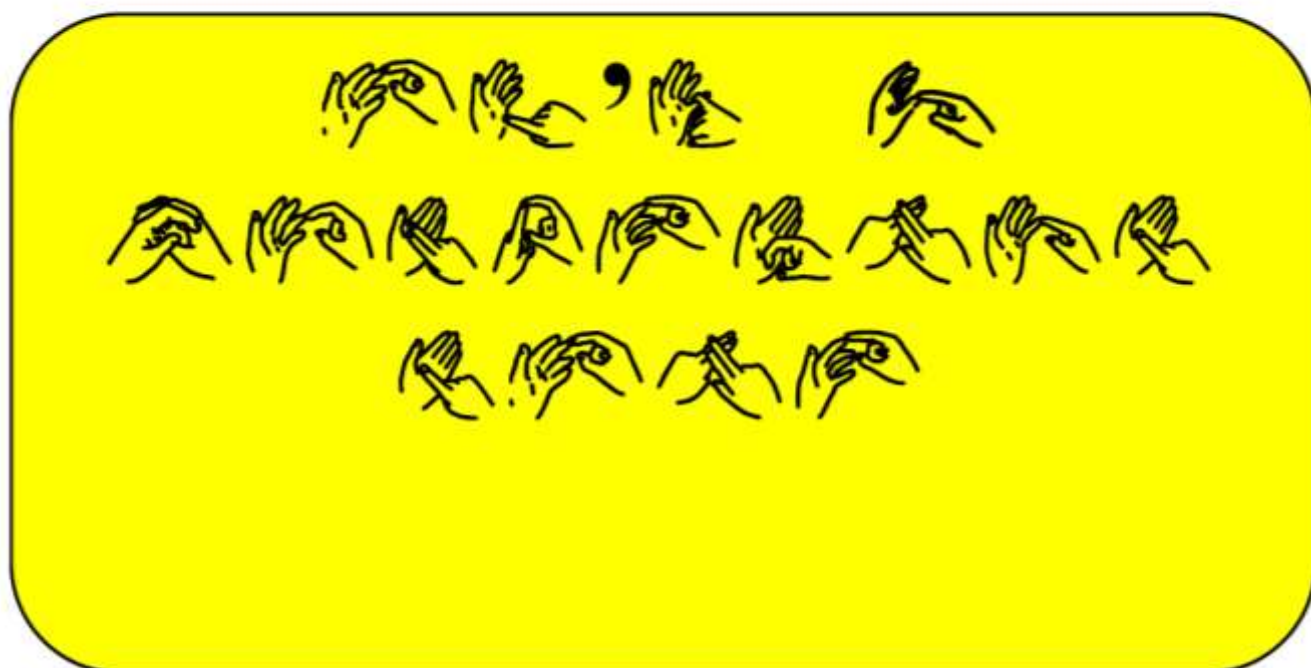
