In groups they used Lego to build roads that include safe places to cross, including a Zebra crossing and traffic lights. Students transformed the classroom into a busy road and role-played their road safety skills using Stop and Go symbols to tell each other when they can safely cross. Over the next few weeks we will be putting our knowledge to the test in the community.

This week, Dragon class had an exciting opportunity to learn the essential life saving skills of CPR with our school nurse, Yvonne. Students worked towards earning a certificate from the British Heart Foundation for completing the course. They had a lot of fun using resuscitation dolls to practice chest compressions to the song "Staying Alive". We are very proud to say everyone earned their certificate on completion of the course.
