In our English lessons, we have dived into the worlds of Jack and the Beanstalk and The Elves and the Shoemaker. We brought these sensory stories to life by engaging in different textures, sounds, and visuals, making the stories more interactive and memorable.

In our art lessons, we've tied in these stories by creating beautiful art pieces inspired by key moments. For The Elves and the Shoemaker, students created shoe prints using paint, mimicking the elves' tiny footprints as they crafted their shoes. Meanwhile, in Jack and the Beanstalk, students painted vibrant leaves to decorate a giant beanstalk, bringing the enchanted plant to life in our classroom.

It's been a wonderful way to blend storytelling and art, and we're excited to explore the tales of 'Puss in Boots' towards the end of this term!

MESSAGE FROM HEAD OF SCHOOL

This week we started the TPP meetings, where Teachers, SaLT, OT and physio get together to look at progress and plan new outcomes for the coming term. We hold TPP meetings in the second half of each term providing regular multidisciplinary input looking at each individual student. Class Teachers welcome hearing any thoughts you have on specific aspects that you wish us to focus on with your child, even if this does not tie in with the EHCP target. Often aspects of your child's development sit outside of skills which may not be taught in other schools, especially working on independence skills such as toothbrushing, using cutlery or developing the ability to wait whilst in a shop or café.
