The summer term is flying by, and Wonder Class has been as busy as ever! Alongside our regular physiotherapy and communication sessions, we have been fully immersed in our topic - The Ocean. This has been brought to life through stories, art, music, and a range of sensory experiences that the students have engaged with beautifully. In our life skills sessions, we have been focusing on keeping safe, helping our young people to develop awareness in a practical and supportive way. We have also enjoyed getting out and about whenever possible, with trips to the park proving to be a firm favourite. The warm weather at the beginning of this week was certainly a challenge, and everyone felt the heat! We slightly relaxed our usual timetable to make sure everyone stayed comfortable, and this created some lovely opportunities for collaborative play, with students engaging positively with one another in a calmer, more flexible environment. Despite the heat, we still managed to have lots of fun by keeping cool in the shade. As part of our ocean theme, the students have explored "underwater kingdoms" and enjoyed sensory beach experiences—listening to the sound of waves and seagulls, and feeling the refreshing cool spray of "crashing waves." These moments have provided wonderful opportunities for both relaxation and exploration. Looking ahead, the slightly cooler weather forecast is perfect timing, as we are very excited about our upcoming trip to Mead Open Farm. We hope this will be a fantastic experience for all our young people, giving them the chance to explore a new environment and enjoy hands-on learning outside the classroom.

Please note that the changes to Free School Meals eligibility will be live from September 2026.

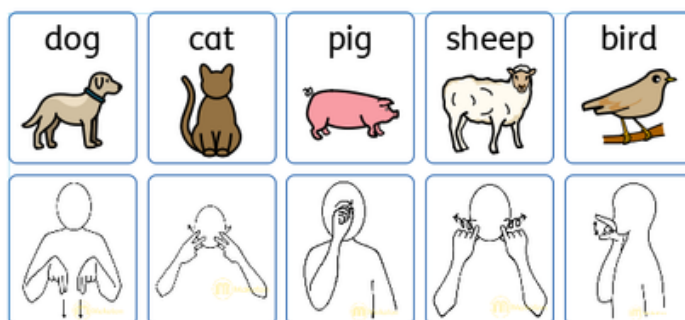
The meal ordering window for next half term WILL CLOSE AT 10AM ON MONDAY 6th JULY.
